We offer Medicare Outreach

SHIIP, which stands for Seniors Health Insurance Information Program, is a free government educational service that can help navigate your choices when it's time to enroll in Original Medicare (Medicare Part A and Part B), a Medicare Advantage Plan (like an HMO or PPO), or a Medicare drug plan. Perquimans County's SHIIP volunteers are located in the Perquimans Extension Office on Edenton Road Street, Hertford, NC. Call 252-426-7697 for an appointment once you receive your Medicare Card or as early as three months before your 65th Birthday.
