

Notice of Second Democratic Primary Election for U.S. Senate

The Perquimans County Board of Elections will hold a Democratic 2nd Primary Election for U.S. Senate on Tuesday June 22, 2010. Any Voter registered as a Democrat will be eligible to vote in this 2nd Primary and also Unaffiliated voters who participated in the Democratic May Primary will be eligible to vote. Unaffiliated voters who did not participate at all in the May primary elections may choose to participate in this Democratic 2nd Primary.

Polls will be open from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m.

Absentee applications will be issued through Tuesday, June 15, 2010 at 5 p.m. These must be returned to the Board of Elections office by 5 p.m. Monday, June 21, 2010 or postmarked on or before June 22, 2010 and received by June 25, 2010 at 5 p.m. for civilian absentee. No postmark is required for UOCAVA under revision in G.S. 163-231 (b) (ii) and (iii) but these must be received by 5 p.m. June 25, 2010 also. Absentees Applications may be made in person or by a relative or a verifiable legal guardian. A voter may also make a written request by mailing the Perquimans County Board of Elections at P.O. Box 336 Hertford, N.C. 27944.

One Stop absentee voting at the Board of Elections office will begin Thursday, June 3, 2010 and end Saturday, June 19, 2010 at 1 p.m.
